Landro L brings to New Zealand the best dressage and show jumping lines on both sides of his pedigree from Europe. Both Landadel and Grande known world wide for producing horses with great movement, jumping technique, type and temperaments onto their progeny.

Landro's sire Landadel was champion 100 day test winner in 1985. He has sired 4 Oldenburg stallion licensing champions and is one of the few horses in the world to sire horses competing at the same world cup final in both dressage and jumping. Landadel is regarded as the most important son of Landgraf carrying on the famous Ladykiller XX line. Progeny include Grand Prix dressage horse Leondardo Da Vinci ridden by Gonnellen Rothenberger and Grand Prix Showjumper Lady Weingard ridden by Marcus Beerbaum.

Landro's mother is by the great Grande. He has produced 33 approved sons and 34 state premium mares and is part of the famous G line. He has produced many children and grand children that have not only competed at Olympic, World Games and World Cup level but have also won and been placed at this level in both Dressage and Showjumping.

Landro L has done limited breeding in Germany but has produced performance horses for both dressage and jumping, including a young son competing in Grand Prix Dressage with Annabel Balkenhol (Ger). He is training up to Grand Prix level. Landro comes from the P.S.I stables in Germany.
